



## FULL DAY EMERGENCY WARDEN TRAINING

**Course Name:** *Emergency Warden Training*

**Overview:** This course combines three units under the Public Safety Package and is designed to deliver information to designated staff working in any industry or workplace to prepare and respond to a variety of workplace emergencies as outlined in Australian Standard AS3745:2010 Emergency Control Organisations and Procedures.

**National Course Code:**

- Identify, Prevent and Report Potential Workplace Emergency Situations (PUAWER001B)
- Operate as part of an Emergency Control Organisation (PUAWER005B)
- Confine Small Workplace Emergencies (PUAWER008B)

**Prerequisites:** None. (However participants should be reasonably fit and able to lift and carry fire extinguishers and other safety equipment or chemical spill kits as required and have clear diction)

**Nominal Duration:** 8 hours training and assessment.
